Pruning your indoor/outdoor bonsai It is important to regularly trim your bonsai to keep its shape or style. This is called the clip and grow method. When a new shoot has elongated, and has between 6 to 8 new leaves, it should be trimmed back to between 2 to 4 leaves. This may be every 2 months or so depending on the vigor of the tree.
