1. Profit Multiplier. In profit multiplier, the value of the business is calculated by multiplying its profit. For example, if your company's adjusted net profit is \$100,000 per year, and you use a multiple like 4, then the value of the business will be calculated as $4 \times \$100,000 = \$400,000$.
